RALLYSCORE SCOTTISH AUTOTEST CHAMPIONSHIP 2024

Title and Jurisdiction

- 1 The Scottish Association of Motorsports Clubs (hereinafter referred to as the SAMSC) will promote a Clubman status Championship to be known as the < RALLYSCORE Scottish Autotest Championship 2024>.
- 2 The Championship will be held under the General Regulations of Motorsport UK (incorporating the provisions of the International Sporting Code of the FIA), The Motorsport UK and Local Government **COVID-19** Guidelines for Events, these Championship Regulations and any written instructions the Championship and the organizing Clubs may issue. The Championship will consist of 3 disciplines – Autotest with reversing, All Forward Autotest and All Forward Production Car Autotest

Competitor Eligibility

- 5 Any person who is a fully elected member of a recognised Club within SAMSC and any other invited Clubs or Association listed on an individual events Supplementary Regulations. All entrants must produce a valid Club membership card and a valid RS Clubman Competition Licence, this Licence is FREE and can be applied for online apart from under 18s who have to submit via a form countersigned by a Parent or Guardian.

Registration

- 6 Registration forms must be returned to the Championship Co-ordinator either by post, email, directly or via the Secretary of the meeting at their first Championship round, online registration is also available on RALLYSCORE via the following link - <https://www.rallyscore.net/#/entry-form/3036?RallyScore-Scottish-Autotest-Championship-Entry-Form>

As this is the fourth year of the resurrected Championship, Registration is **FREE** to encourage new entrants.

Points Scoring

- 7 Points awarded for the Overall Championship will be scored on the basis of 20 for 1st overall, 19th for 2nd, etc., down to 1 point for 20th place, between eligible competitors only. In addition 10 points will be awarded to 1st in class, 9 for 2nd, etc., down to 1 point for 10th, taking all competitors into account and based on event classes. Where only 2 competitors in a class start an event, points will be reduced to 9 for 1st, 8 for 2nd and if only 1 competitor in that class this will be reduced to 8 for 1st. All competitors will receive 1 point per event for starting that event. In addition **ALL** competitors will receive 1 point per event for finishing that event. As a substitute for **ONE** event score any Championship contender who, during the season acts as an official (including marshalling) on any of the Championship qualifying rounds may claim 10 points. Registered contenders will receive a form, those who wish to claim these points must submit this form signed by a senior official of the event to the Championship Co-ordinator within 7 days of the event.

The Championship will consist of no more than 7 events of which a contender's best 6 scores will count. If there are only 6 rounds run the number of events to count will be 5. If there are only 5 rounds run the number of events to count will be 4.

To reduce travelling/fuel costs competitors can use their regional events to count as point scoring rounds in the relevant disciplines they have registered for during the season as various Clubs only run specific disciplines, there are also mandatory events.

There will be 3 mandatory events, of which competitors must enter at least 2 rounds to qualify for the Championship.

In the event of a tie in the Overall Championship, the better score in a discarded round will be counted to resolve the tie. If a tie persists, the second best discarded scores will be counted until the tie is resolved. If a tie still persists then the competitor who scored the greatest number of points first will be deemed to be the winner.

Results

8 Championship results will be published as soon as possible after each qualifying round on the SAMSC website / Facebook page and The Rallyscore.net Scottish Autotest Championship Facebook page and Provisional Results will be published as soon as possible following the last event.

Classes

- 9 The Championship will consist of 6 Classes as follows -
- 1 Autotest Front Wheel Drive Cars
 - 2 Autotest Rear Wheel Drive Cars
 - 3 All forward Autotest, AutoSolo Front Wheel Drive Cars
 - 4 All Forward Autotest, AutoSolo Rear Wheel Drive Cars
 - 5 Production Car All Forward Autotest Front Wheel Drive Cars
 - 6 Production Car All Forward Autotest Rear Wheel Drive Cars

A Novice is defined as a person not having been 1st in Class or better on more than 2 occasions on a Clubman event where the entry in the class was more than 2, and has never won the Novice Award before.

A Junior is defined as being aged 14 – 21 years

To win an award a competitor must score on at least 3 rounds in the Championship . To win a Class award a competitor must score on at least 3 rounds in the Championship in the same Championship Class.

The clubs and dates of the proposed events are correct at this time of publication of these regulations, but there may be additional events, all of the registered competitors will be notified and they will also be published on the SAMSC website and the Scottish Autotest Championship Facebook page when available.

3.1
